



	21/04/2015	<p>Whereas it appears that the State Election Commission, West Bengal has issued Notification vide No. 636-SEC/1E-85/2015 dated 18/03/2015 notifying therein, inter-alia, that the Municipal General Election, 2015 to Suri, Sainthia, Bolpur and Rampurhat Municipality of this district will be held on 25/04/2015 and counting of votes on 28/04/2015;</p> <p>AND whereas it appears further that State Election Commission, West Bengal has issued an order vide no. 1400(41)-SEC/5P-16/2013(Pt.-I) dated 15/04/2015 directing therein, to issue prohibitory order u/s 144 Cr.P.C. in the area around Polling Stations on the date of Poll to prevent law & order problem in the vicinity of the polling stations and conduct of election in a free, fair and peaceful manner;</p> <p>AND whereas in compliance with the said order, it is considered expedient to issue the following prohibitory order in the entire area of Suri, Sainthia, Bolpur and Rampurhat Municipality for smooth, free, fair and peaceful conduct of the said Municipal Election, 2015;</p> <p>Now, therefore, I, Sri P. Mohangandhi, I.A.S., District Magistrate, Birbhum do hereby promulgate order u/s 144 Cr.P.C., 1973 within one hundred metre of all Polling Stations in the jurisdictional areas of entire Suri, Sainthia, Bolpur and Rampurhat Municipalities as well as Distribution-cum-Receiving Centres prohibiting assembly of five or more persons on 24/04/2015 & 25/04/2015 exempting those to be engaged in duty of maintenance of Law & Order and other election duties including Polling Personnel as well as the voters who are standing in the queues.</p> <p>Exigency of the situation does not allow me to</p>


